KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-165

REQUESTING THAT THE STATE OF ALASKA TRANSFER LANDS SURROUNDING NINILCHIK HARBOR FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ALLOW MANAGEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE HARBOR.

WHEREAS, the Ninilchik harbor is surrounded by State land held by the Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Land and Water Management, has issued tidelands permits without providing for management of the harbor; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature has appropriated funds for capital improvement to and for management of the Ninilchik harbor to the Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation is the more appropriate entity to maintain and manage the harbor; and


WHEREAS, such a transfer of harbor land to the Department of Transportation would resolve dual management problems and expedite management of the harbor;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly hereby requests the State of Alaska to transfer lands surrounding Ninilchik harbor from the Department of Natural Resources to the Department of Transportation.

Section 2. That the borough clerk is directed to distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor of Alaska, William Sheffield; Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources, Esther Wunnicke; and Commissioner of the Department of Transportation, Richard Knapp.
