KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-166

REQUESTING ESTABLISHMENT OF A PROGRAM TO PROVIDE FUNDING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE U.S. GOVERNMENT, DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, FOR APPROVED KENAI RIVER BANK STABILIZATION PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, increasing use of the Kenai River has contributed to the erosion of the river bank; and


WHEREAS, it is extremely costly to stabilize the river bank by approved methods of bank stabilization;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly hereby requests establishment of a program to provide funding and technical assistance for approved Kenai River bank stabilization projects from the U. S. Government and the State of Alaska.

Section 2. That the Borough clerk is directed to distribute copies of this resolution to the President of the U.S., Ronald Reagan; U.S. Senate and House of Representatives; Secretary of Defense, Casper Weinburger; U. S. Senators Ted Stevens and Frank Murkowski; U. S. Representative Don Young; Governor of Alaska Bill Sheffield and the Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources; Alaska State Senators Paul Fischer, Jalmar Kerttula, Edna DeVries and John Sackett; and to Alaska Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, Bette Cato, Mike Szymanski and Kay Wallis.
