RESOLUTION 85-168

REQUESTING THE ADMINISTRATION TO FORMULATE A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE WEST SIDE OF COOK INLET.

WHEREAS, there is occurring an intense effort to develop the west side of Cook Inlet; and

WHEREAS, there have been numerous requests from private individuals for an opportunity to bid for or lease Borough lands and resources; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need for certain municipal services on the west side of Cook Inlet such as disposal of solid wastes; and

WHEREAS, there is no up-to-date comprehensive plan for development or land use regulation of either Borough or other lands on the west side of Cook Inlet;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Borough administration is requested to begin formulation of a comprehensive plan for the west side of Cook Inlet to be completed by March 1986, which would include but not be limited to:


1. A procedure for the sale, lease, or use of borough lands and resources on the west side of Cook Inlet by private individuals or public corporations.
2. An inventory of Borough lands and resources on the west side of Cook Inlet.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
