KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-170

REQUESTING THAT THE GOVERNOR OF ALASKA REVIEW THE STATE BIDDING PROCESS TO PROVIDE FOR LOCAL HIRE ON STATE CAPITAL PROJECTS INCLUDING THE SEWARD PRISON PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the unemployment rate in the Seward area and the Kenai Peninsula Borough was over 15% in the last year; and

WHEREAS, the Seward area is particularly in need of new projects to revitalize its economy; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Seward prison is one of the largest state capital projects put out for bid by the State of Alaska in 1985;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly requests the Governor of the State of Alaska to review the entire state bidding process regarding the employment of foreign workers and the impact on local hire.

Section 2. That the assembly also requests that the Governor throw out the bid of Samwhan American, Inc. for the Seward prison if contractual agreement between Samwhan American, Inc. and the State of Alaska does not include a specific local hire provision.

Section 3. That the clerk shall send copies of this resolution to the Governor of Alaska, William Sheffield; to Senators Paul Fischer, Jalmar Kerttula, Edna DeVries and John Sackett; and to Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, Bette Cato, Mike Szymanski and Kay Wallis.
