RESOLUTION 85-175

APPROVING 100% PROTOTYPE DESIGN DEVELOPMENT DOCUMENTS FOR THE NEW CENTRAL PENINSULA HIGH SCHOOL AND THE NEW NIKISKI HIGH SCHOOL AS PREPARED BY ARCHITECT MAYNARD & PARTCH.

WHEREAS, The Kenai Peninsula School Board recommends approval of prototype design development document for the new Central Peninsula and Nikiski High Schools; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has previously approved Resolution 85-137 for 50% preparation of prototype design development documents for the new Central Peninsula and Nikiski High Schools by architect, Maynard & Partch; and

WHEREAS, these design development documents have been submitted to the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, Assembly approval of architectural design development documents and comprehensive cost estimates for the new Central Peninsula and Nikiski High Schools Projects is required;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That design development prototype documents for the new Central Peninsula and Nikiski High Schools projects, prepared by Maynard & Partch architects, are approved together with a design development statement of probable cost as follows:


