RESOLUTION 85-181

IN SUPPORT OF FUNDING FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE RELOCATION OF THE KBBI BROADCASTING FACILITY AS IT IS THE FIRST PRIORITY IN THE ALASKA PUBLIC BROADCASTING COMMISSION LIST OF PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, KBBI, Inc. is a nonprofit membership corporation which operates KBBI Radio Station serving the southern Kenai Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, KBBI provides valuable community and public affairs information to the citizens of the south Kenai Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, KBBI is on the verge of being evicted by the Cook Inlet Region, Inc. from the current location; and

WHEREAS, The Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission has set priorities for funding of public broadcasting facilities in the state and has identified the KBBI relocation project as their number one capital funding priority; and

WHEREAS, an additional grant administered by the Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission is needed to complete this project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough supports the efforts of KBBI to relocate their studio to a permanent location.

Section 2. The Kenai Peninsula Borough requests the Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission, the Department of Administration, the Governor and the legislature to give this request their consideration and support.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately and the Clerk is directed to send copies to Governor William Sheffield, Lieutenant Governor Stephen McAlpine; Senators Edna DeVries, Paul Fischer, Jalmar Kerttula, and John Sackett; and Representatives Betty Cato, Andre Marrou, Mike Navarre, Mike Szymanski and Kay Wallis and a copy to the Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission and the Department of Administration.
