ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR SETTING PRIORITIES FOR ANNUAL RECOM-MENDATIONS TO THE LEGISLATURE FOR FUNDING AND OTHER LEGISLATIVE REQUESTS.

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that priorities for requests to the legislature need to be set well in advance of each legislative session; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly does not have a procedure for setting priorities; and

WHEREAS, both the Public Works and Legislative Committees have worked on a method of prioritizing requests for funding; and

WHEREAS, it would expedite matters if a routine procedure were established;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That in September of each year, at the direction of the president of the Assembly, a letter shall be sent to all cities and service areas within the borough soliciting their legislative and funding priorities. Priorities received shall be transmitted to the Legislative, Public Works or other appropriate Committee as determined by the president of the assembly. Suggestions for priorities of the borough as a whole from the Borough Mayor shall also be submitted by the president to the appropriate committee.

Section 2. that from the lists submitted the committee shall draw up the following:

- Road priorities as determined pursuant to Borough ordinances or resolutions;
- Overall borough priorities;
- 3. Other priorities deemed appropriate by the committee for each of the four election districts of the borough including items of importance to each of those districts but not necessarily to the borough as a whole.

Section 3. That upon completion of each of the three lists the president of the assembly shall place on the agenda of a regular or special assembly meeting a resolution adopting the
