ACQUISITION OF THE FORMER HOMER POSTAL FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the Homer branch of the Kenai Peninsula Community College is an active, vital part of the South Peninsula post secondary education; and

WHEREAS, the Homer branch office has operated from donated administrative and academic space for two years; and

WHEREAS, the private sector space will no longer be available; and

WHEREAS, the University of Alaska has placed this purchase of the former postal facility as a major priority for legislative funding for FY 1986-87;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports the effort of the Kenai Peninsula Community College, Homer Branch, to acquire the former Homer postal facility.


Section 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly requests the Governor and the legislature to give this request their consideration and support.
