RESOLUTION 85-193

REQUESTING THAT THE FOURTEENTH ALASKA LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION, MAKE A SPECIAL APPROPRIATION OR GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIREFIGHTING EQUIPMENT FOR THE BEAR CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Service Area is in need of a pump truck and search and rescue equipment; and

WHEREAS, the equipment would aid in protection of life and property; and

WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Service Area does not have adequate funds to obtain such equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Service Area has approached the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly requesting its support in this matter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly supports the request of the Bear Creek Fire Service Area for a \$50,000 special appropriation or grant for a pump truck to refill fire tankers and an inflatable boat with motor and scuba diving gear for search and rescue and urges that funding be provided by the Legislature through the appropriate agency.

Section 2. That the Clerk shall send copies of this resolution to Governor William J. Sheffield, to Senators Paul Fischer, Edna DeVries, Jalmar M. Kerttula, and John C. Sackett, to Representatives Bette Cato, Andre Marrou, Mike Navarre, Mike Szymanski, and Kay Wallis, and to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs.
