RESOLUTION 85-203

REQUESTING THAT THE FOURTEENTH ALASKA LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION, MAKE A SPECIAL APPROPRIATION OR GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$875,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIREFIGHTING EQUIPMENT AND COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND FOR CONSTRUCTION OF FIREFIGHTING FACILITIES FOR THE KALIFORNISKY FIRE SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the voters established the Kalifornsky Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the Kalifornsky Fire Service Area has no means of obtaining funds until July, 1986; and

WHEREAS, this area of 3,500 people has no fire protection; and

WHEREAS, this is a large area with a nonconnecting road system; and

WHEREAS, the two mill limit on property tax will provide for basic operating costs only;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly supports the request of the Kalifornsky Fire Service Area for a \$875,000 special grant for the following items:

Two pumper trucks	\$200,000
One tanker truck	180,000
Communications system	40,000
Firefighting equipment	30,000
Facilities	425,000

Section 2. That the Clerk shall send copies of this resolution to Governor William J. Sheffield, to Senators Paul Fischer, Edna DeVries, Jalmar M. Kerttula, and John C. Sackett, to Representatives Bette Cato, Andre Marrou, Mike Navarre, Mike Szymanski, and Kay Wallis, and to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs.
