RESOLUTION 85-206

TRANSFERRING RIDGEWAY/STERLING FIRE SERVICE AREA FUNDS FROM THE TRANSFERS ACCOUNT TO MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS AND CAPITAL OUTLAY ACCOUNTS.

WHEREAS, the assembly has authorized the Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area to form and become operational as of November 20, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the accounts and balances of the old Ridgeway Fire Service Area unincorporated into the new Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, there were funds contained in the Ridgeway budget that were not necessary or allocated to maintenance and operations or capital outlays for the Ridgeway Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, these funds may be utilized to provide for operations in the newly added Sterling portion of the Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area without decreasing the services to be provided or expected by the residents of the old Ridgeway fire service area; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area Board has requested transfers of funds to allow effective firefighting in the combined service area;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That pursuant to the request of the Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area Board, \$34,300 be transferred from Account No. 208-513010-47443 (entitled "Transfer of Funds") in the following amounts to the following line items:
