RESOLUTION 85-22

SUPPORTING THE APPLICATIONS OF THE CITY OF HOMER AND KACHEMAK CITY FOR TRANSFER OF LANDS FROM THE STATE FOR PUBLIC USE.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has selected certain lands in the Fritz Creek drainage for conveyance to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, this selection has been approved; and

WHEREAS, the cities of Homer and Kachemak City have made applications for transfer of those lands to them for public use under AS 38.05.810; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly feels that such conveyance to the cities would be for a valid public use to provide a potential water supply;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly concurs in and supports the applications of the City of Homer and Kachemak City for a transfer to them under AS 38.05.810 the lands in the Fritz Creek drainage requested in their applications submitted to the State.

Section 2. That copies of this resolution be sent to the Honorable Wayne Kessler, Mayor of Homer, the Honorable Vicke Fugil, Mayor of Kachemak City, and to the Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources.
