KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-25

RESCINDING RESOLUTION 74-10 AND RESOLUTION 76-5 WHICH OPPOSED THE HARDING ICE FIELD/KENAI FJORDS NATIONAL MONUMENT PROPOSAL.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough did pass Resolutions 74-10 and 76-5 expressing opposition to the proposal for the Harding Ice field/Kenai Fjords National Monument; and

WHEREAS, in December 1980, Kenai Fjords National Park was created by an act of Congress through the Alaska National Interest Lands Act (ANILCA); and

WHEREAS, the National Park Service is now established within the Borough, and is a good neighbor to the community; and

WHEREAS, the National Park Service has worked diligently to promote the tourism industry for the community and to open the recreational resources located within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, it is time to remove any vestiges of animosity that may have once existed because of concerns over the activities of the National Park Service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB Resolution 74-10 and KPB Resolution 75-6 are hereby rescinded.


Section 2. That the National Park Service is welcome as an integral part of the Borough.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
