RESOLUTION 85-26

SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF HB72 AND SB22 WHICH WOULD REVISE TITLE 29 OF THE ALASKA STATUTES PERTAINING TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.

WHEREAS, in previous sessions of the Legislature, bills have been introduced to revise Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes which pertain to local governments; and

WHEREAS, these revisions have been needed and are supported by the Alaska Municipal League; and


WHEREAS, HB72 and SB22 of the current Legislative session reintroduces these revisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough hereby urges and supports the passage of HB72 and SB22 which would revise Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes.


