RESOLUTION 85-31

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION OF A "COOPERATION AGREEMENT" WITH THE COOK INLET HOUSING AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, the Cook Inlet Housing Authority (herein called the "Authority") is a public housing agency and will apply to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for a program reservation in connection with the development of low-income housing; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(e)(2) and 6(d) of the United States Housing Act of 1937, aka 42 U.S.C. §1437(c)(e)(2) and (d), as amended, it is necessary that the Kenai Peninsula Borough enter into a Cooperation Agreement with the Authority providing for local cooperation in connection with such low-income housing project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:



Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and requested to negotiate the Cooperation Agreement in the name and on behalf of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
