KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-34

REFERRING REAPPORTIONMENT OF THE BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO THE LOCAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, it is the proper business of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly to see that seats on the borough assembly are distributed equitably; and

WHEREAS, in distributing seats on the borough assembly consideration must be made for geography, economics, politics, rural/urban lifestyles, and also population; and

WHEREAS, the recent borough-wide census has provided new information concerning population;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the question of whether the borough should be reapportioned is hereby referred to the Local Affairs Committee for review and recommendation to the assembly.

Section 2. That the Local Affairs Committee shall examine all options or methods of reapportionment and all factors involved in equitable apportionment.

Section 3. That for purposes of this task the Local Affairs Committee shall be expanded to include at least one member from each of the assembly districts.

Section 4. That the report of this committee on reapportionment shall be presented to the assembly no later than the first regular assembly meeting in July, 1985.
