RESOLUTION 85-37

AMENDING THE GREER ROAD PROJECT AGREEMENT TO INCLUDE 700 FEET OF TRACY AVENUE SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY OF SUFFICIENT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Homer Electric Association has requested the Borough to upgrade 700 feet of Tracy Avenue to their electric substation as part of the Greer Road project; and

WHEREAS, this upgrade is to provide access for H.E.A.'s emergency mobile substation; and

WHEREAS, D.O.T. has agreed to maintain Tracy Avenue to the substation; and

WHEREAS, providing emergency access to the substation serves the residents of the entire Borough;

WHEREAS, the upgrading of Tracy Road could be efficiently included with the Greer Road project provided that sufficient funding is available to first complete the Greer Road portion;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Borough Assembly authorizes the inclusion of the first 700 feet of Tracy Avenue as part of the Greer Road project.

~~Strike~~ Section 2. ~~That the expenditure of funds from the Greer Road account 231-331022-49999-11226 is authorized for the design of Tracy Avenue.~~

Section 3. That no project funds shall be utilized in construction of the Tracy Road portion of the project unless and until construction of the Greer Road portion is completed.

Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption. ^{and Beaver Creek}
