KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-39

ESTABLISHING PRIORITY PROJECTS FOR FUNDING SCHOOL FACILITIES WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT EDUCATION'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Department of Education submits proposed capital improvements program for school facilities; and

WHEREAS, the projects submitted by the Borough have been prioritized within that budget listing; and

WHEREAS, the School Board and Assembly have not previously prioritized these projects; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly wishes to indicate and establish its priorities for direct funding of these projects within any capital improvements program approved by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly wishes to establish the highest priorities for funding of projects for the Soldotna Elementary School renovations, the new Hope School, Nikiski High School, and the Nikiski Elementary School;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly hereby establishes the following priorities in descending order for funding of projects submitted within the Department of Education's capital improvement budget to be submitted to the Governor and the Legislature.


1. Soldotna Elementary School (renovation).
2. The school facility at Hope, Alaska (new construction).
3. The Nikiski High School (new construction).
4. The Nikiski Elementary School (new construction).

Section 2. That these priorities are the priorities for funding and are not to exclude any other projects submitted by the Borough and the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District from funding within the capital improvements program budget.



Section 3. That copies of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable William J. Sheffield, Governor of the State of Alaska, to the Commissioner of the Department of Education, to Senators Paul Fischer, Jalmar Kerttula, Edna Armstrong-DeVries

and John Sackett, and to Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, Bette M. Cato, Mike Szymanski, and Kay Wallace.
