RESOLUTION 85-42

SETTING AN ADVISORY VOTE OF THE BOROUGH ELECTORATE ON THE SALE AND USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, over the past few years the Assembly has considered several ordinances relating to the control on sale and use of fireworks within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, there have been proposed a variety of methods of control and prohibition of sale and use of fireworks through these ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the testimony elicited by the hearings on those ordinances has been concerned mainly with the views of those with a financial stake in the sale of fireworks; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly feels that it is in the best interest of the populace to determine the views of the general public on various options in the control of sale and use of fireworks;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That an advisory vote of the Borough electorate be scheduled for the next general election of the Borough concerning the control of sale and use of fireworks.

Section 2. That the ballot for the advisory vote shall include two options as follows:

Regarding Borough regulation of fireworks outside cities, which of the following do you favor?

1. A total ban on sale and use of fireworks within the Borough.
2. No ban on the sale and use of fireworks.

Section 3. That Resolution 85-27 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
