KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-46

CLASSIFYING A PORTION OF BOROUGH OWNED LAND IN THE NIKISKI AREA AS PUBLIC USE LAND TO BE RETAINED FOR USE BY THE KENAI PENINSULA SCHOOL DISTRICT AS A HIGH SCHOOL SITE.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has received a State patent to portions of Section 36, T8N, R12W, S.M. located within the Nikiski Area; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Board of Education met on February 11, 1985 and approved the selection of subject land for a high school site; and


WHEREAS, the Planning Commission met February 25, 1985 and recommended adoption of this resolution by a 8 - yes, 2 no vote;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T8N, R12W, S.M. Alaska, containing 40 acres more or less be classified as public use land.

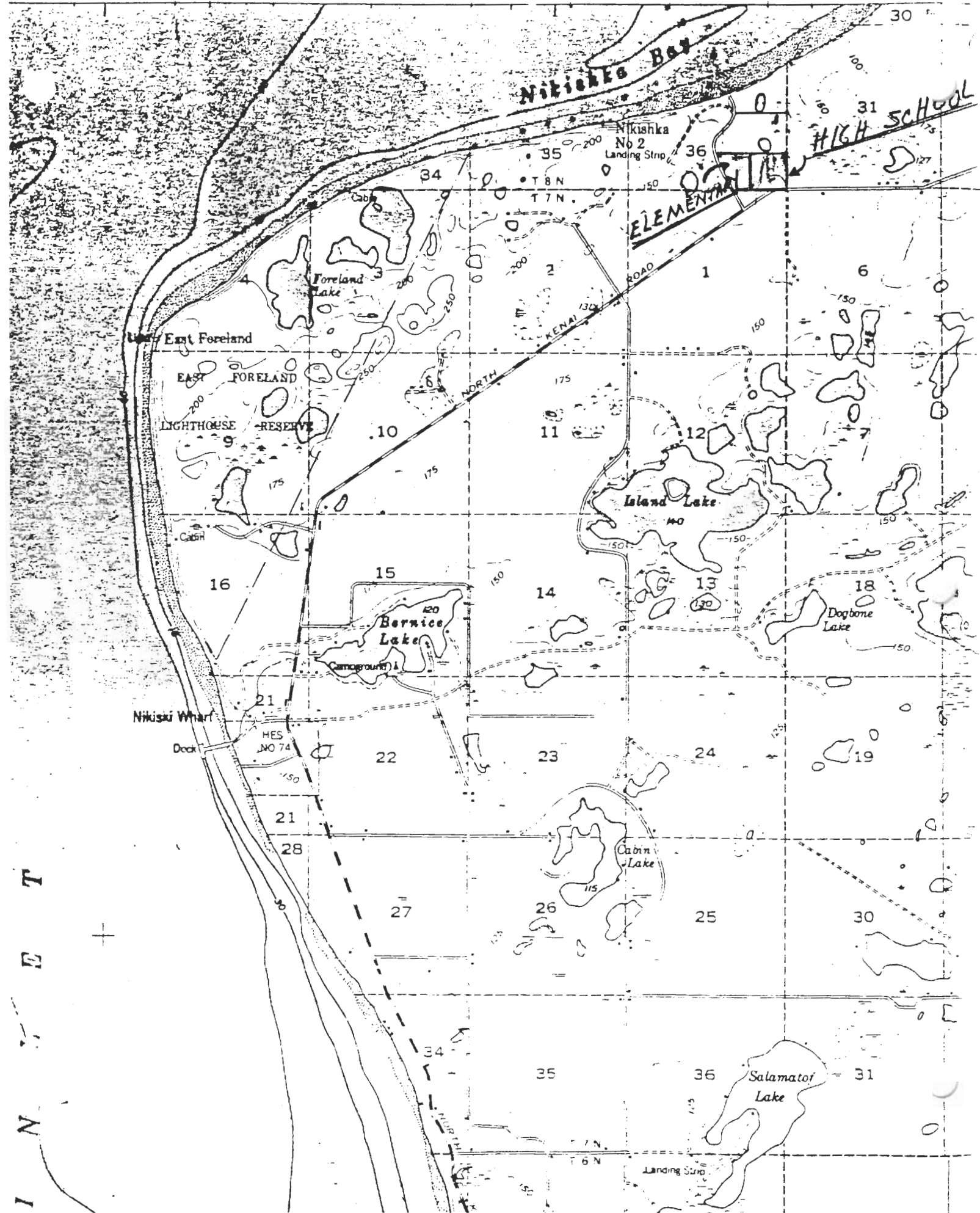
Section 2. That the boundaries will be set after final design.
