KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-48

CLASSIFYING A PORTION OF BOROUGH OWNED LAND SOUTH OF SOLDOTNA IN THE ARC LAKE AREA AS PUBLIC USE LAND TO BE RETAINED FOR USE BY THE KENAI PENINSULA SCHOOL DISTRICT AS A SCHOOL SITE.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has received a State patent to portions of Section 12, T4N, R11W, S.M. located approximately 1½ miles south of the City of Soldotna; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Board of Education met on February 25, 1985 and approved the selection of subject land for a high school site; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission met on February 25, 1985 and a motion to recommend the subject site failed by a 5 - yes, 5 - no vote; and


WHEREAS, the Planning Commission met again on March 11, 1985, and after considering additional information a motion to recommend the site failed by a 3 - yes, 4 - no vote;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the E½ North of the Sterling Highway, Section 12, T4N, R11W, S.M. Alaska, containing 160 acres, more or less be classified as public use land.

Section 2. That it is the intention that 40 acres more or less be allocated to the school site. The boundaries are to be determined at final design.
