RESOLUTION 85-56

SUPPORTING THE KENAI PENINSULA LATCH-KEY PROGRAM COMMITTEE AND THEIR REQUEST FOR LEGISLATIVE FUNDING.

WHEREAS, there has been a recent survey of central peninsula elementary school children showing over 600 potential users of a latch-key program; and

WHEREAS, there is a Kenai Association for the Education of Young Children, and an Inter-agency Latch-key Committee; and

WHEREAS, that committee has investigated similar programs in Alaska, and developed a proposed program and budget for the school year 1985-1986; and

WHEREAS, the latch-key program is considered a preventive measure in juvenile crime;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH;

Section 1. That the assembly supports the latch-key committee in its efforts to obtain legislative funding in the amount of \$80,000.

Section 2. That a copy of this resolution be mailed to Governor William Sheffield, Senators Fischer, DeVries, Kerttula and Sackett, and to Representatives Navarre, Marrou, Cato and Szymanski.
