WHEREAS, an element critical to the success and continued improvement of our Kenai Peninsula Borough School District is actively supportive citizenry;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:
