RESOLUTION 85-69

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATIONS FOR TRADE OF BOROUGH OWNED LAND IN THE NIKISKI AREA FOR SALAMATOF NATIVE CORPORATION OWNED LAND IN NIKISKI AREA, LAND TO BE CLASSIFIED AS BOROUGH OWNED LAND AND TO BE USED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA SCHOOL DISTRICT AS AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE FOR THE NEW PROPOSED 1985 BOND ISSUE, NIKISKI ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, The Kenai Peninsula Borough School Site Selection Committee met on March 29, 1985 and recommends E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Lot 1, Sec. 36, T7N, R12W, S.M. Approximately 25.7 acres as new site for the proposed new Nikiski Elementary School, and;

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission approves Borough negotiations for a land trade with Salamatof Native Corporation, and;


WHEREAS, The School Board recommends placement of the New Nikiski Elementary School site on Lot 1, Section 36, T7N, R12W, S.M., and;

WHEREAS, The Salamatof Native Corporation has expressed an interest in Borough owned land in Nikiski Section 11, T6N, R12W, S.M. approximately 22.1 acres.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate a trade of Borough owned land located in Nikiski, Section 11, T6N, R12W, S.M. approximately 22.1 acres with Salamatof Native Corporation owned land located in Nikiski E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Lot 1, Sec. 36, T7N, R12W, S.M., approximately 25.7 acres.
