RESOLUTION 85-70

IN SUPPORT OF HOUSE BILL 296 PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES FOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Alaska House of Representatives is currently considering House Bill 296 regarding appropriations for various road construction projects; and

WHEREAS, HB 296 would provide funding for several needed road construction projects within the Kenai Peninsula Borough on state, borough, and city level road projects;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly strongly supports the appropriation of funds under HB 296 for the various road construction projects within the Kenai Peninsula Borough as such construction is necessary for continued provision of an efficient and safe transportation system within the borough.

Section 2. That the clerk is directed to provide copies of this resolution to Governor Bill Sheffield, and to Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, Bette Cato, Mike Szymanski and Kay Wallis.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
