KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-71

IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL 178 REGARDING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT GRANTS FOR SCHOOL PROJECTS ON THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, Senator DeVries has introduced into the State Senate a bill which provides for appropriation of funds in the sum of \$26,873,793 to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for grant funding of the Nikiski High School complex and the new Hope School; and

WHEREAS, these school projects are very necessary to provide facilities for a continuing provision of excellent education on the peninsula;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly strongly supports passage of Senate Bill 178 providing for the appropriation of \$26,873,793 from the general fund for capital improvement grants necessary for the Nikiski High School complex and new Hope School projects.

Section 2. That the clerk is hereby directed to provide copies of this resolution to Governor Bill Sheffield, and to Senators Paul Fisher, Jalmar Kerttula, Edna DeVries and John Sackett.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
