KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-72

SUPPORTING SENATE BILL 37 AND HB 235 PROVIDING FOR MANAGEMENT PLANS AND REGULATIONS FOR SUCH PLANS TO BE ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF FISHERIES.

WHEREAS, SB 37 and HB 235 provide for adoption of management plans and regulations to implement management plans for the fisheries of the State of Alaska, and where such plans will include the allocation of fisheries resources among different user groups in order to conserve or develop fisheries resources; and

WHEREAS, such legislation would require findings-of-fact to support limitations or exclusions on a particular group's use of the fisheries; and


WHEREAS, such legislation would be beneficial to the fisheries within the Kenai Peninsula Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly of the Borough expresses its support of, and urges passage of SB 37, and its companion HB 235 providing for management plans and regulations to be adopted by the Board of Fisheries governing the allocation of fisheries resources among different user groups in Alaska.

Section 2. That the Borough Clerk shall distribute copies of this resolution to Senators Paul Fischer, Jalmar Kerttula and Edna DeVries, and to Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, Bette Cato and Mike Szymanski.
