RESOLUTION 85-73

IN SUPPORT OF CONTINUED FUNDING OF THE LEGISLATIVE INFORMATION OFFICES AND TELECONFERENCE SITES ON THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

WHEREAS, there was established a Legislative Information Teleconference site beginning in 1979 by the Eleventh Session of the Alaska State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the number of teleconferences and participation by the public has doubled as well as number of bills distributed; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Office provides for the educational concerns of the adult community as well as school children; and

WHEREAS, it is less costly and easier to provide for this method of local legislative access than to move the State Capital; and


WHEREAS, there has been some indication funds may be cut from this important program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly urges funding of all of the Legislative Information and Teleconference sites in the Borough at the same level as this past year.

That the clerk is directed to provide copies of this resolution to Governor Bill Sheffield, House Finance Chairman Adams, Senate Finance Co-Chairmen Faiks and Sackett, Senators Paul Fischer, Jalmar Kerttula, Edna DeVries and to Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, Bette Cato, Mike Szymanski and Kay Wallis.
