KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-77

GRANTING ALL BOROUGH INTEREST IN CERTAIN ROADS BY QUITCLAIM DEEDS TO THE STATE OF ALASKA.

WHEREAS, under the Alaska Municipal Assistance Program, the Kenai Peninsula Borough is reconstructing certain state maintained roads within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, other roads have been reconstructed under the Local Service Roads and Trails Program; and

WHEREAS, in order to construct these roads certain easements were obtained by the Borough from private owners; and

WHEREAS, a certain parcel was purchased by the Borough for right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, construction of certain of these roads has been completed and the right-of-way maps recorded in the applicable recording district;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the interest of the Borough, if any, in the easements and land acquired by the Kenai Peninsula Borough for the construction of the following roads be granted to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, State of Alaska, by quitclaim deeds:

Project #MA-21037	Halbouty Road
#G-11226	Feuding Lane


Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to sign said quitclaim deeds.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
