KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-81

IN SUPPORT OF PRESERVATION OF THE HISTORIC SAXTON CABIN LOCATED WITHIN THE CHUGACH NATIONAL FOREST.

WHEREAS, the Saxton cabin is an historic structure built over fifty years ago on the lands north of Lower Summit Lake between the Seward Highway and Canyon Creek within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough assembly strongly supports the preservation of historic sites within the borough; and

WHEREAS, the Saxton cabin is in good repair and of fine recreational value in addition to its historic value; and


WHEREAS, the U.S. Forest Service has clearly signaled its intention to require removal of the Saxton cabin by June 30, 1985;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly strongly supports the preservation of this historic cabin in its historic location within the Chugach National Forest considering its great historic and recreational values.

Section 2. That the clerk is hereby directed to provide copies of this resolution to Michael Barton, Regional Forester, U.S. Forest Service, Juneau, AK; to Senators Ted Stevens and Frank Murkowski; and to Representative Donald Young.
