RESOLUTION 85-84

APPROVING THE SCHEMATIC DESIGN DOCUMENTS FOR THE NIKISKI HIGH SCHOOL AND THE CENTRAL PENINSULA HIGH SCHOOL AND AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO PROCEED WITH THE DESIGN DEVELOPMENT PHASE ON THOSE PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly has previously awarded the contract to Maynard and Partch Architects to provide architectural services for the proposed Nikiski and Central Peninsula High Schools (Resolutions 84-203 & 84-204); and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School Board has approved the schematic documents; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 85-19 appropriates funding for design development services for those projects;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

- Section 1. That the schematic documents submitted by Maynard & Partch Architects for the proposed Nikiski High School are approved, and the Assembly approves the proposed scope and nature of the project outlined in the schematic documents.
- Section 2. That the schematic documents submitted by Maynard & Partch Architects for the proposed Central Peninsula High School are approved, and the Assembly approves the proposed scope and nature of the project outlined in the schematic documents.
- Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to allow Maynard and Partch Architects to proceed with the design development phase for the proposed Nikiski and Central Peninsula High Schools in accordance with the contract documents previously executed at a cost not to exceed \$231,500 for design development for Nikiski High School, \$231,500 for design development for Central Peninsula High School.
- Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to execute change orders to the project management services agreement with Morrison Knudsen to include services for the Nikiski High School and Central Peninsula High School during the design development phase at a cost not to exceed \$26,290 for Nikiski High School and \$26,290 for Central Peninsula High School.
- Section 5. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate and enter contracts for soils investigation and surveying at a cost

not to exceed \$60,000 for the Nikiski High School and \$60,000 for the Central Peninsula High School.

Section 6. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
