KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-97 (SUBSTITUTE)

ACCORDING EQUAL TREATMENT AS TO WAGES AND SALARIES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES EXCLUDED FROM THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH AND THE KENAI BOROUGH EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, some employees of the Borough are excluded from the collective bargaining agreement entered into between the Borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association; and

WHEREAS, these employees should be accorded equal employment as to wages, salaries, and benefits of employment by the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Assembly grants to these listed employees who are excluded from the employee bargaining unit the same wage, salary, and benefits, including overtime, provided other employees of the Borough that are covered by the agreement:

1. Legal Secretary
2. Personnel Assistant
3. Executive Secretary
4. Associate Legal Secretary



Section 2. That, subject to agreement with the Kenai Peninsula Borough Employees' Association, the Sr. Clerk Typist for the Clerk's office be excluded from the collective bargaining agreement, and that this position shall be accorded the same treatment as the employees listed in Section 1 of this resolution.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect June 24, 1985.
