KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 86-5 (SUBSTITUTE)

APPROVING THE SCHOOL BOARD RECOMMENDATION FOR THE TUSTUMENA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION AND REMODEL (1987), TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE COMPLETED PROJECT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNTS FOR SCHEMATIC DESIGN SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CARMEN VINCENT GINTOLI ARCHITECT.

WHEREAS, the School Board has recommended the Tustumena Elementary School addition and remodel (1987) project for the 1986 bond issue; and

WHEREAS, bond funds are available from completed projects; and

WHEREAS, the School Board is charged by Alaska Statute 14-140.060 (E) with determining design criteria for school buildings and with selecting the architect to develop these designs, subject to the approval of the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the School Board has reviewed architectural firms; and

WHEREAS, the School Board recommends Carmen Vincent Gintoli Architect for the project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

Section 1. That the School Board's recommendation of the Tustumena Elementary School addition and remodel for 1987 is approved.

Section 2. That funds in the amount of \$22,455. from Susan B. English account No. 401-740100-49999-81159 and \$15,545 from Kenai Central Account No. 401-730200-49999-81162 for a total of \$38,000 are hereby transferred to the Tustumena School Account No. 401-711300-49999-86247 for schematic design and comprehensive cost projections, soil investigations and site surveying.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate contract with Carmen Vincent Gintoli architectural firm for professional services.


Section 4. That the architect, Carmen Vincent Gintoli is authorized to proceed with schematic design and cost projections at a cost not to exceed \$30,844.00.

Section 5. That the contract with the architect shall provide that the architect shall not have the right to proceed with the preparation of design development or subsequent phases without prior Assembly approval.


Section 6. That the Mayor is authorized to contract for site survey at an amount not to exceed \$7,156.

Section 7. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
