KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
RESOLUTION 86-6 (SUBSTITUTE)

APPROVING THE SCHOOL BOARD RECOMMENDATION FOR THE NEW HOMER ELEMENTARY, NEW SEWARD ELEMENTARY AND THE NEW CENTRAL PENINSULA ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS, TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE COMPLETED PROJECT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNTS FOR SCHEMATIC DESIGN SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ARCHITECT WIRUM & CASH.

WHEREAS, the School Board has recommended the new Homer Elementary, new Seward Elementary and the new Central Peninsula Elementary School projects for the 1986 bond issue; and

WHEREAS, bond funds are available from completed projects for schematics; and

WHEREAS, the School Board is charged by Alaska Statute 14-140.060 (E) with determining design criteria for school buildings and with selecting the architect to develop these designs, subject to the approval of the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the School Board has reviewed architectural firms; and

WHEREAS, the School Board recommends Wirum & Cash architectural firm for the project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

Section 1. That the School Board's recommendation of the new Homer Elementary, new Seward Elementary and Central Peninsula Elementary School projects are approved.

Section 2. That funds from Homer Middle School, Account Number 401-720300-49999-83254 for a total of \$25,500 are hereby transferred to the following school project accounts:

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate contract with Wirum & Cash architectural firm for professional services.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to contract for soils investigation and site survey at an amount not to exceed

\$25,500.

Section 7. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
