KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 86-104

PLACING ON THE BALLOT FOR THE REGULAR BOROUGH ELECTION, RATIFICATION OF THE BOROUGH ORDINANCE LIMITING THE TERM OF THE MAYOR TO TWO CONSECUTIVE TERMS.

WHEREAS, As 29.20.030(C) enacted in 1985, effective January 1, 1986, provides that no limit may be placed on the total number of terms served by a borough mayor except by ordinance ratified by the voters; and

WHEREAS, KPB 2.04.010 states that the borough mayor shall serve no more than two consecutive terms; and

WHEREAS, KPB 2.04.010 has not been ratified by the voters of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to bring KPB 2.04.010 into compliance with AS 29.20.230(C) and with Section 89 of Chapter 74, SLA, the "savings clause" of new Title 29;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following question shall be placed on the ballot for the regular election scheduled for October 7, 1986:

"Do you approve Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 2.04.010, which limits the term of office of the borough mayor to two (2) consecutive terms?"
