RESOLUTION 86-107

PLACING ON THE BALLOT FOR THE REGULAR BOROUGH ELECTION, APPROVAL OF A 10% DECREASE IN BOROUGH EMPLOYEES' SALARIES.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly wishes to ascertain from an advisory vote of borough voters their opinion of a 10% decrease in borough employees' salaries;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following question shall be placed on the ballot for the regular election scheduled for October 7, 1986:

"Which of the following options do you wish the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly to consider regarding borough employees' salaries?" (check one)

- A 10% across the board salary decrease;
- A salary and benefit cap of \$50,000 for all employees;
- Neither one of the above.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
