RESOLUTION 86-11

TRANSFERRING THE OLD RESURRECTION RIVER BRIDGE TO THE IDITAROD TRAILBLAZERS FOR USE ON THE IDITAROD TRAIL.

WHEREAS, a new bridge has been constructed across the Resurrection River to the Exit Glacier; and

WHEREAS, the Borough owns the walking bridge that was removed when the new bridge was completed; and

WHEREAS, the Iditarod Trailblazers Association has requested the bridge be given to them to supply a creek crossing on the Iditarod Trail;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the old Exit Glacier walking bridge over the Resurrection River is declared surplus property and is to be transferred to the Iditarod Trailblazers Association for use as a stream crossing along the Iditarod Trail within the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Section 2. That when no longer needed or used on the Iditarod Trail within the Kenai Peninsula Borough the bridge ownership shall revert to the Borough and the Iditarod Trailblazers will be responsible for returning the bridge at no cost to the Borough.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to take all actions reasonably necessary to carry out this resolution.

Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
