ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY REDUCTION IN ASSEMBLY MEMBERS' REMUNERATIONS

WHEREAS, the mayor has reduced wages and salary costs by ten (10) percent and has taken steps to reduce other operating costs; and

WHEREAS, KPB 2.12.060(B) provides for assembly members to voluntarily forego any remunerations; and

WHEREAS, the proposed temporary ten (10) percent reduction in remunerations to assembly members can best be described as symbolic, however, now is the time for the members of the Assembly to demonstrate leadership through example;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Compensation--Additional expenses. [A.]  
Assembly members [ASSEMBLYMEN] shall receive an allow-  
ance for expenses which would otherwise not be reim-  
bursed in the amount of \$180.00 [\$200.00] per month,  
except the assembly president, who shall receive a  
similar expense allowance in the amount of \$225.00  
[\$250.00] per month.

Section 2. Compensation--Per diem and travel expenses.  
B. Assembly members shall receive an allowance of \$135.00  
[\$150.00] per month for use of the personal automobile on  
borough business, and shall be reimbursed for mileage  
recorded on authorized borough business trips at the rate  
of \$.45 per mile.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect at 12:01 a.m.,  
September 1, 1986 and end at midnight on December 31, 1986.
