## RESOLUTION 86-127

AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS BOROUGH PERSONAL PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Borough and the Borough School District have declared certain items of personal property surplus to their needs; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly on August 4, 1970, adopted a memorandum outlining procedures for disposal of surplus property which required an appraisal of all property prior to disposal; and

WHEREAS, an appraisal requires the expenditures of time and monies far beyond its worth;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- Section 1. That provisions for the August 4, 1970, memorandum requiring appraisal of surplus property prior to disposal will be waived and an auction will be held at 10 a.m., October 25, 1986. (As amended; Hayor vetoed and original Sept. 27 was effective date.)
- Section 2. That the auction will be legally advertised in a newspaper of the Borough at least 10 days prior to the auction.
- Section 3. That personal property to be auctioned will be on public display on Friday, October 24%, in the former maintenance yard from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. (\*As amended; Mayor vetoed and original Sept. 26 date was effective.)
- Section 4. That a professional auctioneer will conduct a public outcry auction based on the highest bid, in accord with regular auctioneering rules and practices.
- Section 5. That a list of surplus property for this auction will be submitted to the Assembly at the September 16, 1986, Assembly meeting.
- Section 6. That the administration seek proposals from three licensed auctioneers doing business in the Kenai Peninsula Borough in formulating the contract for auctioneering services.
- Section 7. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
