REQUESTING YUKON PACIFIC TO CONSIDER NIKISKI AS A TERMINUS FOR THE PROPOSED GAS PIPELINE.

WHEREAS, the local economy of the location of the terminus for the proposed gas pipeline will be greatly stimulated by such location; and

WHEREAS, the Nikiski area is an advantageous location for the pipeline terminus because of existing oil and gas industry development and support services;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough requests that Yukon Pacific consider locating the terminus of the proposed gas pipeline in Nikiski.


Section 2. That copies of this resolution be sent to the borough Resource Development Commission; the State of Alaska, Department of Economic Development; and officials of Yukon Pacific.
