KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 86-156

GRANTING HOMER ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION A UTILITY EASEMENT ACROSS BOROUGH OWNED LANDS.

WHEREAS, Homer Electric Association has requested an easement for a guy wire to be placed on Borough property; and

WHEREAS, this request is on Borough lands leased to Offshore Systems, Inc. who has no objection in granting this easement; and

WHEREAS, the granting of this easement would provide the needed electricity in the maintenance and expansion of Arness dock and vicinity; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission at it's regularly scheduled meeting of November 3, 1986 recommended approval of this easement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a utility easement for electrical lines described as running  $\pm$  1,935 feet in length by 10 feet wide containing  $\pm$  0.44 acres and  $\pm$  1,485 feet in length by 20 feet in width containing  $\pm$  0.68 acres as shown on the attached plat be granted on and across tax parcel lands 012-020-09, 012-020-10, and 012-020-11.

Section 2. That upon completion of installation Homer Electric Association will provide the Kenai Peninsula Borough with a copy of an as-built survey depicting the location of the electric lines.


Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate this easement.

Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
