KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 86-163

AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A RECREATION AREA AND FACILITIES IN THE NORTH PENINSULA RECREATION SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Board has approved a "Comprehensive Park and Recreation Plan" for the area which identifies a family recreation area and hiking/cross-country ski trail system in the area of Nikiski, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Land and Water Conservation Fund, federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies; and

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Board passed a resolution on November 25, 1986 to approve the making of a formal application to the State Liaison Officer for such federal funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough considers it in the best public interest to develop a family recreation area and hiking/cross-country ski trail system in the Nikiski area on borough-owned land in the Kenai Peninsula Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to make formal application to the State Liaison Officer for funding assistance for the development of a family recreation area and hiking/cross-country ski trail system in the Nikiski area on borough-owned land within the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area and the borough.


Section 2. That the service area's share of the project will be derived from its budget.

Section 3. That any property acquired with financial aid through the State Liaison Officer be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless otherwise provided and agreed to by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly, the State Liaison Officer and the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service.


Section 4. That this resolution become part of a formal application to the Alaska Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation.

Section 5. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
