KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 86-19

AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO RELINQUISH ITS FOREST SERVICE PREFERENCE RIGHT FOR THE SOLID WASTE TRANSFER SITE AND SCHOOL SITE IN COOPER LANDING AND SELECTING THESE SITES PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL ENTITLEMENT ACT.

WHEREAS, in error, the State of Alaska requested that the Borough relinquish its selection of the solid waste transfer site and school site located in Cooper Landing; and

WHEREAS, the Borough formally relinquished its selection of the Cooper Landing solid waste transfer site and school site; and

WHEREAS, to correct this error the Borough should relinquish its Forest Service Preference Right and reselect these sites as part of its municipal entitlement under ADL 201307;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough hereby relinquishes its Forest Service Preference Rights of ADL 201349 and ADL 201350 located within Section 28, T5N, R3W, S.M.


Section 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough selects the following described lands from the State of Alaska pursuant to the Municipal Entitlement Act and to be included in selection number ADL 201307:
