KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 86-20

GRANTING HOMER ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION AN ELECTRICAL EASEMENT ACROSS BOROUGH OWNED LANDS.

WHEREAS, Homer Electric Association has requested an easement for a guy wire to be placed on Borough property; and

WHEREAS, this request is on Borough lands reserved for the use of an emergency service station operated by the Ridgeway Fire Service Area by Ordinance 81-91; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Service Board met and voiced a non-objection of the requested easement; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission at it's regularly scheduled meeting of January 20, 1986 recommended granting this easement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a utility easement for a guy wire anchor described as being a 10 foot by 15 foot rectangle as shown on the attached plat be granted on that portion of land described as the:

Begin 923.21 ft. S 29° E of West intersection of  
N Sec. line of Sec. 29 and Kenai Spur;  
Thence S 29° E 300 ft.;  
Thence South 61° West 300 ft.;  
Thence N 29° W 300 ft.;  
Thence N 61° East 300 ft. to P.O.B., containing  
2.1 acres, more or less, in Sec. 29, T5N, R10W, S.M.


Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate this easement.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
