RESOLUTION 86-35

APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE KALIFORNISKY BEACH SCHOOL PROJECT UNASSIGNED CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FOR ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION 86-6 (SUBSTITUTE).

WHEREAS, Resolution 86-6 (substitute) only provided funding for soils and surveying for the Homer, Seward and Central Peninsula Elementary school projects; and

WHEREAS, funds are now available for the architectural/engineering services necessary to site adapt the proposed schools; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 86-6 (substitute) approved the selection of Wirum Cash for the architectural/engineering services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That funds from the Kalifornsky Beach school project unassigned contingency account number 401-949010-49999-82156 in the amount of \$96,000.00 are hereby transferred to the following accounts;


New Homer Elementary	401-720500-49999-86246	\$ 32,000
New Seward Elem.	401-750300-49999-86243	\$ 32,000
New Central Pen. Elem.	401-711600-49999-86244	\$ 32,000

Section 2. That the architect Wirum & Cash is authorized to proceed with schematic design and cost projections on these projects at a cost not to exceed \$96,000.


Section 3. That the contract with the architect shall provide that the architect shall not have the right to proceed with the design development or subsequent phases without prior Assembly approval.

Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
