RESOLUTION 86-41

APPROVING CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS PREPARED BY ARCHITECT MAYNARD & PARTCH FOR THE 1985 SCHOOL BOND NEW PROTOTYPE NIKISKI AND CENTRAL PENINSULA HIGH SCHOOLS AND AUTHORIZING BIDDING PHASE.

WHEREAS, at the regular election held in the Kenai Peninsula Borough on the 1st day of October, 1985, the qualified electors of the Kenai Peninsula Borough authorized the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds for the purpose of constructing and equipping the new Nikiski High and Central Peninsula High Schools; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School Board recommend approval of construction documents for these high schools; and

WHEREAS, Assembly approval of construction documents and comprehensive cost is required prior to bidding; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the construction documents and statements of probable cost for the high schools prepared by Maynard & Partch are approved. The statement of probable cost are:

| Nikiski High School | \$22,700,000.00 | \$30,240,000.00 |
| Central Pen. High School | \$20,817,000.00 | \$28,215,000.00 |

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the bidding phase for each of these projects.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
