RESOLUTION 86-42

APPROVING CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS PREPARED BY ARCHITECT TRA-FARR FOR THE 1985 SCHOOL BOND NEW HOPE K-12 SCHOOL AND AUTHORIZING BIDDING PHASE.

WHEREAS, at the regular election held in the Kenai Peninsula Borough on the 1st day of October, 1985 the qualified electors of the Kenai Peninsula Borough authorized the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds for the purpose of constructing and equipping a new school in Hope for grades K-12; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School Board recommend approval of construction documents for the Hope school project; and

WHEREAS, Assembly approval of construction documents and comprehensive cost for the Hope K-12 school is required prior to bidding;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the construction documents and statements of probable cost, for the Hope school prepared by TRA-FARR are approved. The statement of probable cost is:

Hope School K-12	\$ 2,665,530.00	\$ 3,820,000.00


Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the bidding phase for this project.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
