KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 86-51

APPROVING THE USE OF \$60,000 FOR SUPPLEMENTARY FUNDING TO EXPAND THE ADEC-BOROUGH JOINT SPONSORED 1986 ANNUAL SPRING HAZARDOUS WASTE CLEANUP TO INCLUDE HOMER AND SEWARD IN ADDITION TO KENAI-SOLDOTNA.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) has indicated that its 1986 budget for spring hazardous waste cleanup is extremely limited and that the Borough would need to contribute \$10,000 to insure the proposed cleanup in Kenai-Soldotna would be successful; and

WHEREAS, ADEC has indicated that the Borough could, if it so desired, completely sponsor additional borough cities through its 1986 spring cleanup contract, thus saving considerable administrative time and costs; and

WHEREAS, neither Homer nor Seward have ever had a spring hazardous waste cleanup; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works department has estimated that in addition to the \$10,000 for the Kenai-Soldotna cleanup, that \$30,000 and \$20,000 would be needed for cleanups in Homer and Seward respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly placed \$100,000 in the 1985-86 waste commission budget for the purpose of performing a hazardous waste study; and

WHEREAS, the waste disposal commission, after reviewing the present hazardous waste situation, in the state as well as the Borough, recommended not doing the study at this time; and

WHEREAS, the \$100,000 will lapse back to the general fund at the end of the current fiscal year;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly approves the use of \$60,000 contained in the waste disposal commission budget Act.# 100-321090-43011 to provide for the 1986 spring hazardous waste cleanup in Kenai-Soldotna, Seward, and Homer, and that the sums of \$10,000, \$20,000, and \$30,000 are designated for each respective area.

Section 2. That the assembly also authorizes the Borough administration to work with ADEC and through the ADEC hazardous waste clean-up contracts to achieve the intent of this resolution.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
