KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 86-58

DECLARING THE INTENTIONS OF THE ASSEMBLY CONCERNING WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITIES IN THE CENTRAL PENINSULA AREA.

WHEREAS, disposal of solid waste is the responsibility of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the collection of solid waste requires adequate sites for the disposal of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, the solid waste sites currently in operation within the city of Kenai and just to the south of the city of Soldotna should be phased out as soon as is practicable;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Waste Disposal Commission is hereby directed to select a primary and secondary location for a new central peninsula area landfill site.

Section 2. That the Waste Disposal Commission shall, in making its recommendation for a new central peninsula area landfill site, include locations that could at some future time accommodate an incinerator facility.

Section 3. That the assembly hereby declares its intention to close the Soldotna and Kenai landfills at the earliest practicable date.

Section 4. That it is the intention of the assembly that the landfill be designated and operated using the best available systems for containment of waste and the monitoring and the necessary treatment of leachate produced.

Section 5. That the recommendations of the Waste Disposal Commission shall be presented to the borough mayor and the borough assembly as soon as possible but no later than November 4, 1986.

Section 6. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
