KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
RESOLUTION 86-70 (ALTERNATE)

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO PROCEED WITH THE CONTRACTS FOR THE ARCHITECTURAL, PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE 1985 SCHOOL BOND PROJECT, HOPE SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Resolution 86-42 approved construction documents and statement of probable cost prepared by architect TRA/Farr and authorized bidding phase; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids for construction of Hope School were solicited and opened by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Finance Department on May 1, 1986;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to G & S Construction in the amount of \$2,150,300 and this would include the base bid and Alternate 1 for the construction of Hope School.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to architect TRA/Farr in the amount of \$31,925 for construction phase architectural services.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to Morrison-Knudsen Co. in the amount of \$117,068 for construction phase project management service.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with utility services, testing services and other services as required for completion of the Hope School project.

Section 5. That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to complete this project in accordance with this resolution and project appropriations.

Section 6. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
